

W. D. Abrams Dies Thursday Afternoon

Funeral services for Warren DeCosta Abrams, age 74, were held from the First Methodist Church at 4:00 p.m. Friday. The pastor, the Rev. James Elliott, and the Rev. Carl Tolleson of Talladega officiated. Burial was in Alexander City cemetery, Langley in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Abrams died at 3:00 p.m. Thursday, February 23. He was a native of Tallapoosa County and spent his early life in and near the Hackneyville community.
