To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Solomon Adams, of Dallas County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Cahaba whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Solomon Adams according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North East Quarter of Section Nine, in Township Fifteen, of Range Seven, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Cahaba, Alabama containing Eighty acres, and Fifty six hundred sixths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Solomon Adams

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Solomon Adams and to his heirs, the said tract above ascribed:

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Solomon Adams and to his heirs and assigns forever.
