To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS *Bedding Canterbury, of Lowndes County Alabama,*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at *Cahaba* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Bedding Canterbury according to the provisions of the **Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands,"** for *the South West quarter, of the North East quarter, of Section Twenty eight, in Township Twelve, of Range Thirteen, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Cahaba, Alabama, containing Thirty nine Acres, and Eighty one hundredths of an Acre,*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract *has* been purchased by the said *Bedding Canterbury*

NOW KNOW YE, That the **United States of America,** in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *Bedding Canterbury*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Bedding Canterbury* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Millard Fillmore* **PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** have caused these Letters to be made **PATENT,** and the **SEAL** of the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.
