Whereas, Samuel Canterbury of Lowndes County Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Cahaba whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Samuel Canterbury according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North ^{Quarter} of the North West quarter of Section Twelve in Township Thirteen of Range Thirteen in the District of Land subject to sale at Cahaba Alabama containing forty acres and twenty eight hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel Canterbury

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Samuel Canterbury and to His heirs, the said tract above described:

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Samuel Canterbury and to His heirs and assigns forever.
