Albert Gayle Thompson was b. 10-14-1846 near Letsworth in the Parish of Pointe Coupee, La., and d. 1-16-1924, Parish of Grant, Colfax, La. He married 4-24-1895 at St. Francisville, West Feliciana, La., Katie Belle Gastrell, b. 4-1-1873, St. Francisville, d. 6-13-1938 at Natchitoches. She was the daughter of Alfred Thomas Gastrell and his wife Hattie Isabelle Cockrell. Albert Gayle Thompson was educated at Pointe Coupee Parish Schools and Washington College, Va. He was a prominent citizen and planter on Red River and became a soldier in the Confederate Army in March, 1862, enlisting in the Pointe Coupee Battery at Fort Pillow, Tenn., and served until the close of the war, May, 1865. He received a good education in St. Mary's College, Kentucky, and supplemented the same by attending Washington College, Virginia. General Robert E. Lee was then president of the College. He taught school first in West Feliciana Parish and then in Alexandria, La. From there, he came to the plantation in Grant Parish owned by his parents. This plantation is still in the possession of two of his children, Alberta G. Thornton and Richard S. Thompson - Route 2, Colfax, La. Katie Belle received a good education in Nazareth Academy, Kentucky. Children:
