 sideration of the sum of five hundred Money to me now on hand
 paid by W^m Surbottle of great Price in Britain County and Province of
 South Carolina, being friend and Neighbour of the said Holland, the Testis
 whereof is hereby acknowledged and also for Divers other good Causes and
 Considerations me therein moving, Have given granted and confirmed
 and by these presents do give grant and confirm unto the said William
 Surbottle all these following Articles Viz: Fifty Head of battle hanging on
 Bee River and sufficient marked some thereof with an under figure
 in one ear, and two under halfpennys in the other, others marked with a cross
 and under bit in one ear and slit in the other, some not branded and some
 branded thus: It and fifty Head of Swine marked with a cross and under
 slit in one ear, the other whole with, eight head of horse kind some being
 branded thus & other thus: 3. all being of different Colours, with ten head
 with four feather Beds, and furniture, with all Kitchen and household
 furniture unto me belonging and all Carpenters and Plantation Tools,
 it all being formerly the Property of the said Joseph Holland, and
 now or near my Plantation, at Maice Bluff Ferry, to have and to hold
 the said Stocks and increase Goods and Chattels unto the said William
 Surbottle his lasts Admors and assigns for ever, upon the special trust &
 confidence, Nevertheless, and to and for the several Uses, Intent and Pur-
 poses herein after mentioned and some other that is to say upon trust
 that he the said W^m Surbottle his lasts Admors and assigns do and shall
 permit the said Mary Holland During her Natural Life to have, hold
 use, employ, occupy and enjoy the afore recited Stocks and increase
 Articles and thing herein contained and immediately after Death of
 the said Mary, upon trust and to and for the Use of the Children of the
 said Mary then living to be equally divided amongst them, the said Stocks and
 Increase, Articles and things herein contained shall not be liable to or in
 any Manner chargeable with payment of any Debts, Contracts or En-
 gagements of the said Joseph Holland, nor liable of being seized, Man-
 aged or assigned on claims thereof. IN WITNESS whereof I have
