## Will of Stephen Hawkins, 1869 Lowndes County, AL

Will of Stephen Hawkins, dated 18 Dec. 1869 (Lowndes Co., Al.)--filed 1876.

"In the name of God, Amen, I, Stephen Hawkins of said county, being of sound mind and memory at the time of publishing this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all others, and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory like, do therefore make and publish this my last will and testament, That is to say:

First, after all my lawful debts and funeral expenses are paid and discharged, the residue of my estate, real and personal, whereof I may did siezed or possesed, I give, bequeath and dispose of as follows: To Wit:

That my said Executors shall pay to each of my children John Hawkins,

Thomas Hawkins estate, Stephen M. Hawkins, Wm Hawkins, Henry Hawkins, Sarah Acreman, Eliza WIlliams, Martha Holladay, Mary Ann Adams, Fanny Holladay, the sum of ten dollars out of my estate of moneys which I may have on hand at my dimiss,

Second, I give, bequeath and dismiss all the reast, residue and remainder both real and personal to my beloved wife, Mary Hawkins, likewise I do hereby make constitute and appoint my said wife of the County of Lowndes, State of Alabama, to be Executors of my last will and testament, and to act as such without bond.

In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal the 18th day of December A.D. 1869."

Note: the wife, Mary, above was his third wife (first wife was named Mary

[Etheridge] also). Third wife was Mary Adams Manning.
