County in the State of North Carolina being tho weak in body yet of sound & perfect memory
walling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed all men once to die do make &
contain the my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say I give & command
My soul to the hand of Almighty God who gave it & my Body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
manner at the discretion of my Executor hereafter mentioned not Doubtling but as the General Reservation
I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God as touching such worldly Estate as I hath plan
the Almighty God to Bless me I give & dispose of the same in the manner & form following
In testimony I give & bequeath to my son Matthew Howell to him & his heir forever my two Negro fellow
servants King & Tom. Item I give & bequeath to my son in law James Howell to him & his heir forever
the Negro fellow & Dick & Tom. Item I leave to my Grandson William Shiner the Lands &
beautys of Thomas Shiner as will appear by deed from said Shiner one feather bed & furniture
my young slave man also my Negro boy Dick my Negro woman Lettie also my two negro girls
Lily & Lettie to him & his heirs & as lawfully begotten of his body with all their future increase of the
said Shiner or the wife thereof have fully begotten then my desire is that what I leave him may be
Equally divided among all my children.
