She further declares that her said husband Nicholas Johnson deceased Colonel in Florida Indian war and in turn the service at Monmouth on or about the year 1818 as near as she can recollect, in the Company commanded by Captain John Hednett from Talfer County in the State of Georgia (the name of the Regiment she does not know, ^{but continues by her husband's} for the term of 3 months, and continued in said war the full term of his engagements & was honorably discharged at Monmouth on or about the first of the year 1819, as also will more clearly & fully appear by the Muster & Pay rolls of said Company, the discharge having been lost so that she cannot lay her hands on it.

She further states that she was married to the said Nicholas Johnson on the 8th day of June 1815 by one Henry Slaughter, a Justice of the Peace, and that her name before her said marriage was Margaret Jordan that her said husband died at his residence in Troup County in the State of Georgia on the 24th day of October 1835, and that she is still a widow.

She makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty lands to which she may be entitled, under the Act passed September 28th 1850 and that she has not received any bounty lands for some time.
