ANCESTOR'S SERVICE

"Section 1. Any man shall be eligible to membership in the Society who, being of the age of twenty-one years or over, and a citizen of good repute in the community, is the lineal descendant of an ancestor who was at all times unfailing in his loyalty to, and rendered active service in, the amount of the community of the service constraints of independence, either as an officer, soldler, seaman, marrine, militaman, or minute Declaration of Independence; or as a member of a Committee of Safety or Correspondence; or states, or as a sign any Continental, Provincial, or Colonial Congress or Legislature; or as a recognized patriot who performed actual service by overt acts of resistance to the authority of Great Britain."—Constitution of National Society S.
