Will of David Kinkead - Washington County, Va.  
27 Jan 1779

- To wife WINNIFRED KINKEAD - 5 cows, choice of beds & furniture, pewter, young black horse, large iron pot, house & bible during her lifetime - to descend to son JOSEPH KINKEAD
- To grandson DAVID (my son JOHN'S son) - my plantation & plantation tools to take care of his grandmother
- To DAVID SIMPSON - 200 acres on Cove Neck
- To grandson DAVID KINKEAD (son JOHN'S son) - cow
- To HOBSON KINKEAD - colt, my rifle gun
- To DAVID KINKEAD (JOSEPH'S son) - 200 acres at Hunter's Ford

Rest to disposal of my son JOHN KINKEAD - to be disposed of among himself, his children & ELIZABETH KINKEAD & my son BURROWS' two children (grandson DAVID and his sister PHEBE KINKEAD). Ready money divided between my daughter ELIZABETH, son BURROWS' children (DAVID & PHEBE).

This John Kinkead, son of David & Winnifred, is the one mentioned most often in Washington Co. Va. records. He was politically active and was one of the trustees appointed to insure completion of the "Wilderness Road" through the Cumberland Gap.
