Grace to him and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son Jacob Odam my Plantation
and Land ~~and~~ whereon I now live containing one hundred Acres

as Formerly Bounded also one Negro girl named Trichin to him
and his heirs for ever also my Cyder cask likewise one Hackle

Also one Brass kettle to him and his heirs for ever my will and

Desire that my wife and my Daughter Ruth Odam may not be
Molested in my house and Plantation During the Time they live

Together and live Single

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Ruth Odam one Negro
Girl named Cate also one Feather Bed and Furniture also

One large Trunk also my Pewter that I now own
