I desire that my Daughter Ellen Lincine have a good bed and bed clothing One good Milk Cow and Dow and Pigs, or money to buy the same.

Item 7th

I desire that my Executors shall have the management of my Farm, Superintend their rearing, collection of Rent, and see that the necessary repairs are made from time to time, the expense to be paid out of my estate.

Item 8th

I desire in the distribution of my estate that each of my heirs account for the amount they have received, and that all indebtedness by them to me be paid out of their respective shares of my estate.
