

I desire that all my property both real and personal be kept together by my Executors herein after named, and peace for the support maintenance of my wife and Anne Childers that may be living with me at my death, my Realty consisting of my farms on Hightower River containing between five and six hundred Acres more or less, my personal property consisting of Horses, Mules, Cows Hogs &c. all of this property to be kept together and managed by my Executors for the best interest of my heirs and Wife, unless my wife Mary Pascal should die or intermarry, in that event I want my Executors to divide up my estate, and my Childers shall enjoy equal benefits from the distribution of my property.

Item 4<sup>th</sup>

I desire at the death of my wife that all of my property both Real and Personal, and choses in action be sold and disposed of by my Executors under such terms as shall seem to them to be best interest of my estate, and be distributed among my heirs or their legal representatives equally.

Item 5<sup>th</sup>

I desire that my Executors give my daughter J. E. Wiltraps out of my estate the amount of property she brings here, when she come here to live with me also to pay her a reasonable amount for the services she has rendered me while living with us, and her son John L. Wiltraps to have a horse or mule worth One hundred dollars, and One good Bed and bed clothing for the same.

Item 6<sup>th</sup>

I desire that my Daughter Ellen Childers have a good bed and bed clothing One good milk cow and sow and pigs, or money to buy the same.

Item 7<sup>th</sup>

I desire that my Executors shall have the management of my Farm, and maintain the planting, collection of Rents and see that the necessary repairs are made from time to time, the expenses to be paid out of my estate.

Item 8<sup>th</sup>

I desire in the distribution of my estate that each of my heirs account for the amount they have received, and that all indebtedness by them to me be paid out of their respective shares of my estate.

Item 9<sup>th</sup>

I hereby appoint my two sons, John S. Pascal, Samuel Washington Pascal, with Wiers L. Hawkins Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal, This the fourth day of March Eighteen hundred and eighty two
