

Item 5th

I desire that my Executors give my daughter A. E. Willatrop out of my estate the amount of forty dollars she having been where she came to live with me, also to pay her a reasonable amount for her service she has rendered me while living with me, and her son John L. Willatrop to have a Horse or Horses and one or two Harnesses saddles, and one good Bed and Bed clothing for the same

Item 6th

I desire that my daughter Ellen Greenwell have a good Bed and Bed clothing one good Milk pail, and Saw and Pipe or Money to buy the same.

Item 7th

I desire that my Executors shall have the management of my Farms and improvements the Rearing, Collecting of Rents and see that the necessary repairs are made from time to time, the expenses to be paid out of my estate

Item 8th

I desire in the distribution of my estate that each of my heirs account for the amount they have received, and that all parcels taken by them to me be paid out of their respective shares of my estate.

Item 9th

I hereby appoint my two sons John J. Pascoe, Samuel Washington, Pascoe with Cyrus L. Hawkins Executors of this my last will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the Fourth of March Eighteen hundred and Eighty two
